If you have been wondering where **Fr Gordon Quinn** has been all these weeks, I am delighted to announce that he is expected back from the UK this very week. **Our warmest thanks** to Frs Bill Burston and Max Davis who celebrated Sunday Mass at Adamstown and Cardiff with us, during this time. The plan is for Fr Gordon to resume at Cardiff on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> October.

Here's a reminder to parents of Yr 3 children of all primary schools within All Saints Parish boundaries, who wish to prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and Eucharist.

**The essential** information and **registration** night for the **Sacramental Course** will be held in St Philip's Church at Kotara **this Wednesday 17 October at 6.30pm**. You are asked to bring **full details** of your child's Baptism, or a copy of the certificate itself; to complete the registration form for the three sacraments.

If a child was not baptised in one of our three churches, please contact the particular parish for a copy of the certificate; unless you have one at present. You will need to tell that parish: the name of the Church, the date of the Baptism and the names of both parents (at the time of the Baptism) to assist in finding the record. Please arrange this now to allow time to receive their email reply before the meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> October.

As always, registration night and the course itself, will be conducted by **volunteers**; so you are asked to come prepared to note all information given on the night, as well as to fill out the application form accurately and completely (to simplify administration). The lessons begin on 29<sup>th</sup> October.

If you know a family who may not read this Bulletin, **kindly pass this info on**.

Because **All Saints Day** falls on Thursday this year, the whole parish is invited to celebrate **our feast** with the **5.30 vigil** at Kotara on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November; with a **BYO picnic** to follow. Let's make this a great celebration of our three communities: St Kevin's, St Columba's and St Philip's.

### FIRST READING *Wis 7:7-11*

*A reading from the book of Wisdom*

I prayed, and understanding was given me;  
I entreated, and the spirit of Wisdom came to me.

### SECOND READING *Heb 4:12-13*

*A reading from the letter to the Hebrews*

The word of God is something alive and active;

it cuts like any double-edged sword but more finely: it can slip through the place where the soul is divided from the spirit, or joints from the marrow; it can judge the secret emotions and thoughts. No created thing can hide from him; everything is uncovered and open to the eyes of the one to whom we must give account of ourselves.

### GOSPEL *Mk 10:17-27*

*A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark*

Jesus was setting out on a journey when a man ran up, knelt before him and put this question to him, 'Good master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?' Jesus said to him, 'Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: You must not kill; You must not commit adultery; You must not steal; You must not bring false witness; You must not defraud; Honour your father and mother.' And he said to him, 'Master, I have kept all these from my earliest days.' Jesus looked steadily at him and loved him, and he said, 'There is one thing you lack. Go and sell everything you own and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me.' But his face fell at these words and he went away sad, for he was a man of great wealth.

Jesus looked round and said to his disciples, 'How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!' The disciples were astounded by these words, but Jesus insisted, 'My children,' he said to them, 'how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.' They were more astonished than ever. 'In that case' they said to one another, 'who can be saved?' Jesus gazed at them. 'For men' he said, 'it is impossible, but not for God: because everything is possible for God.'
